he Agency for Energy Efficiency (AEE) is a public, budgetary legal entity, under the responsibility of the Ministry of Infrastructure and Energy. AEE is responsible for improving and promoting energy efficiency throughout the energy cycle, in all sectors and economic zones of the country, enabling consumers to reduce their energy supply costs and reduce the negative impact on environmental pollution and climate change. To achieve this, AEE undertakes a series of activities in the field of energy efficiency. The most important responsibilities of the EEA are set out in detail in Article 25 of the EE Law, and include the:

- i. Development, implementation and monitoring of policies, secondary legislation and programs to promote energy efficiency in residential, industry, transport and agricultural sectors
- ii. Development and monitoring of the NEEAP and the preparation of an annual progress report regarding its implementation
- iii. Cooperation with market participants and stakeholders to develop a database to monitor progress in improving energy efficiency
- iv. Development of technical standards and regulations to improve the energy efficiency of products in residential, industry, transport and agricultural sectors
- v. Evaluation of projects that improve energy efficiency for potential funding from the EE Fund
- vi. Support, advice and training to end users on energy efficiency programs
- vii. Verification of the accuracy of data from energy audits, if deemed necessary

In its day-to-day operations, the EEA works closely with other public institutions to support citizens and businesses to invest in technology and efficient solutions, promoting various incentives, information sharing and sectoral best practices.
